
The following instructions are intended to assist the user in the installation of a float pan and securing it with pan clips. Please read all assembly instructions before installing float pans.

#### REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

- Hoist and Safety Strap
- Four Jack stands

#### **PARTS**

Verify that all parts are accounted for (Figure 1 and Table 1).

#### **WORK SAFELY!**

Only a **qualified service technician** with proper training should perform this installation. Follow all shop safety rules when performing this installation.

#### **PREPARATION**

- 1. Make sure trowel is turned off and engine is cool.
- Place the trowel in an area free of dirt and debris.

- 3. Using a hoist, attach safety straps to lifting loops on each side of trowel. Lift trowel approximately 6 inches off the ground.
- 4. Set jack stands in 4 corners to support trowel then slowly lower trowel to the jack stands.

#### **INSTALLATION**




Figure 2. Float Pan Installation

Refer to Figure 2 for location of parts.

- 1. Remove the float pan (P/N 32026) from the box.
- 2. Open the Pan Clip Kit (P/N 32239). Confirm that it contains 3 clips and 3 pins.
- 3. Slide the float pan under the spider plate/blade assembly keeping in mind the alignment of the locator tabs that are welded in place on the pan. Each pan has three sets of locator tabs that will line up with three individual trowel arm/blade assemblies.
- 4. Slowly lower trowel to pan.
- 5. Slide the clip into the trowel arm.
- 6. Insert pin through the first tab on the pan, through the clip, then through the other tab on the pan.
- 7. Rotate pin so that the long end is facing down towards the pan.
- 8. Repeat steps 5 to 7 for the other 2 sets of locator tabs.
- 9. Repeat the entire procedure on the other spider plate/blade assembly.
